



Watershed Coordinator

Join an interdisciplinary team to aid in monitoring and managing watersheds throughout Campbell County, WY! The Campbell County Conservation District (CCCD) works to promote and protect the natural resources of Campbell County. CCCD is accepting resumes for a full time Watershed Coordinator. The CCCD Watershed Coordinator will work closely with state and federal agencies and private landowners to collect chemical and biological data that will aid in the management and understanding of water quality within Campbell County.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

- Knowledge and experience using current approved chemical and biological sampling techniques. Must be familiar with developing research in your field, evaluating results, and integrating findings into planning and decision making.
- Ability to work with CCCD staff, agency personnel and private landowners. Excellent communication and relationship skills are mandatory.
- Minimum requirement of a Bachelor Degree related to Aquatic Ecology, Fisheries Habitat or related field and two (2) years experience.
- Computer, software, and technological knowledge and skills expected of a natural resource professional.

GENERAL DUTIES:

- Gathers data, interprets, analyzes and makes recommendations to determine and improve water quality. Follows the plans and directives of the District to protect water quality, soils, livestock, wildlife, and range.
- Establishes sampling schedules and assimilates information needed to develop data, sample collection points, watershed monitoring locations, and projects. Correctly enters data into database and keeps information current.
- Coordinates with the federal, state, and county agencies and landowners as needed to perform sampling or monitor District plans or project development.
- Performs sampling, maintains equipment including calibration and cleaning.
- Develops written reports, reviews proposals, organizes assignments, and prepares documents or presentations as directed.
- Creates and monitors a fiscal year budget for the program. Oversees purchasing for the program and outsourcing of chemical analysis.
- Assists with other district programs as needed.
